What to expect when Voting in Person

BEFORE HEADING TO THE POLLS

- Go to VoterView.org and verify
 - If you are Registered to Vote
 - Confirm that your Address is correct: If you address is incorrect call the County Clerk at 870-425-3475
 - View a sample ballot
 - Choose to Early Vote at First United Methodist Church on West Road or choose to vote on Election Day at any of Baxter County's vote centers
- Locate your approved photo ID. Below are examples of approved photo ID:
 Photo ID issued by the following
 - The United States,
 - The State of Arkansas,
 - Any Postsecondary Educational Institution accredited in the State, or Trade School, or
 - The County Clerk
 - If the Photo ID displays an expiration date, it must either be current or not expired more than four years before the date of the election in which the person seeks to vote
 - If you do not have an approved photo ID you can contact the Election Commission Office at 870-580-5602 or County Clerk's Office at 870-425-3475
- Electioneering is not allowed within a 100 feet of the main entrance of the polling location or inside the voting area. Examples of Electioneering are:
 - T-Shirt, Hat, Stickers (Anything with a candidate name or logo on it.)
 - Talking about the candidates, measures or anything else on the ballot.

CHECK IN PROCEDURES

- Sample Ballots and Voting information will be available at all vote centers
- A tablet with the link to VoterView is available at all vote centers
- Have your approved photo ID ready
- Go to the check in station (Poll Book)

- You will show the election official your approved photo ID
- You will be required to state: Name, Address and Date of Birth
- The Election Official will verify your information on the tablet
- You will sign the tablet
- The ExpressVote Printer will print the precinct information on your ballot
- The Election Official will hand you your ballot
- Take your ballot and photo ID to the Sign-In table

EXPRESSVOTE PROCEDURES

Voting instructions will be available on the Expressvote

- Place your ballot in the Expressvote
- Mark your selections on the ExpressVote
- Review your selections on the screen
 - o To make a change, touch a selection to return to the ballot
- Print Ballot
 - Please review your ballot after it has printed!
 - If you need to make any changes please alert an Election Official. Do not place your ballot in the ballot box.
- Take your ballot to the ballot box (DS200)

BALLOT BOX PROCEDURES (DS200)

- Review your ballot. Ballot selections are printed on the ballot
- If you would like to change a selection, vote for a contest that you skipped or if you find an error: Do not place your ballot in the ballot box!
- See an Election Official
- Place you ballot on the green arrow of the ballot box
- Wait until the ballot box screen displays "Thank you for Voting"
- Take an "I Voted" Sticker

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY ADDRESS IS INCORRECT?

- Voter will go to the Supervisor
- Voter will fill out an Address Change Card
- Supervisor will call County Clerk to change address and confirm that the address is in Baxter County
- Voter will vote a Regular Ballot

WHAT HAPPENS IF I AM NOT FOUND IN THE POLL BOOK?

- Voter will go to the Supervisor
- Supervisor will call the County Clerk to verify if the Voter is registered
- If the County Clerk verifies that the Voter is registered the County Clerk will add the Voter to the Poll Book: Voter will vote a Regular Ballot
- If the County Clerk cannot confirm the Voter's registration the Voter will vote a Provisional Ballot

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY DATE OF BIRTH OR NAME IS DIFFERENT?

- Voter will go to the Supervisor
- Voter will complete a new Voter Registration Card
- Voter will vote a Regular Ballot

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T HAVE AN APPROVED PHOTO ID?

- Voter will go to the Supervisor
- Voter will be given a Provisional Ballot
- Voter will receive instructions on returning to the County Clerk's office to provide approved ID
- If you don't have a form of approved photo ID, please call our office before the Election, to discuss options for getting an approved photo ID

WHAT HAPPENS IF I BELIEVE THAT I HAVE RECIEVED THE WRONG BALLOT?

- Alert an Election Official
- Do not place your ballot in the Ballot Box! You will not be able to receive a new ballot if it has already been placed in the ballot box

 The Supervisor will work with you and the County Clerk's office to make sure you receive the correct ballot

WHAT HAPPENS IF I CHANGE MY MIND OR SKIPPED A VOTE FOR A CANDIDATE OR ISSUE?

- Alert an Election Official
- Do not place it in the Ballot Box! You will not be able to receive a new ballot if it
 has already been placed in the ballot box
- The Supervisor will be able to re-issue you a new ballot

WHAT HAPPENS IF I NEED ASSISTANCE AT THE POLLING SITE?

- Please let an Election Official know
- If you need assistance two poll workers will provide help
- Voters can also bring someone to assist them or select someone within the polling site
- The assistant should do so without comment or interpretation
- All ExpressVotes are equipped to allow Voters with disabilities to vote unassisted
- Limits on assisting: No one other than Election Officials may assist more than six Voters in marking and casting a ballot at an Election

WHAT HAPPENS IF I REQUESTED AN ABSENTEE BALLOT AND NEVER RECEIVED THE ABSENTEE BALLOT OR WOULD LIKE TO VOTE IN PERSON?

- Voter will go to the Supervisor
- Voter will vote a Provisional Ballot
- If the County Clerk does not receive the original absentee ballot, the Voter's Provisional Ballot will count, provided there were no other issues
