AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BAXTER COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICY MANUAL AND THE BAXTER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PERSONNEL POLICY MANUAL; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

Article 1: <u>Affirmation</u> It has been determined by the Baxter County Quorum Court that the amendment in the Baxter County manual is necessary to improve the overall effectiveness and efficiency of the Baxter County Government. Baxter County has provided evidence authorized by the Court to establish a Technology Resource Policy within the Personnel Policy Manual for Baxter County and the Baxter County Sheriff's Office Personnel Policy Manual.

<u>Section 1.</u> The Baxter County Quorum Court hereby approves the changes and additions, as shown by attached Exhibit "A", Act 504 of 2023. "An act to require public entities to create a policy concerning the authorized use of technology resources and a cyber security policy; and to amend the duties of the state cyber security office."

<u>Section 2.</u> SERVERIBILITY CLAUSE. If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections on the Ordinance and shall be severable.

<u>Section 7.</u> CODIFICATION. This Ordinance is to be codified in the Baxter County Code of Ordinances, §240.00, paragraph (1) and (2) and supersedes all previous Personnel Policies coded therein.

Article 2: <u>Effective Date</u> This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared. This Ordinance shall be in place full force and in effect September 5, 2023, after its passage.

200.12 Technology Resources

This policy is established in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 25-1-126.

Technology resources is defined as:

- a) The machines, devices, and transmission facilities used in information processing, including computers, word processors, terminals, telephones, cables, software, and related products;
- b) The devices used to process information through electronic capture, collection, storage, manipulation, transmission, retrieval, and presentation of information in the form of data, text, voice, or image and includes telecommunications and office automation functions;
- c) Any component related to information processing and wired and wireless telecommunications, including data processing and telecommunications hardware, software, services, planning, personnel, facilities, and training.
- d) The procedures, equipment, and software that are designed, built, operated, and maintained to collect, record, process, store, retrieve, display, and transmit information, and the associated personnel, including consultants and contractors; and
- e) All electronic mail accounts issued by a public entity.

Baxter County's technology resources shall not be used to:

- a) Express a personal political opinion to an elected official unless the opinion is:
 - i. Withing the scope of the employee's regular job duties; or
 - ii. Requested by an elected official or public entity;
- b) Engage in lobbying an elected official on a personal opinion if the employee is not a registered lobbyist for the public entity;
- c) Engage in illegal activities or activities otherwise prohibited by federal law or state law; or
- d) Intentionally override or avoid the security system integrity procedures of the public entity.

Each Elected Official shall create disciplinary procedures for a violation of this policy concerning authorized use of technology resources. The disciplinary procedures created pursuant to this section shall not apply to employee communications made in compliance with the Public Employees Political Freedom Act of 1999, Ark. Code Ann. §§ 21-1-501, et seq., or the Arkansas Whistle-Blower Act, Ark. Code Ann. §§ 21-1-601, et seq.
