AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A 911 ADVISORY BOARD

Article 1: <u>Affirmation</u> The Baxter County Quorum Court finds it necessary to establish a 911 Advisory Board due to cities contributing funds to 911 and to provide alternative and more cost-effective methods for 911 services.

Section 1. For Baxter County to efficiently provide 911 services, the County will establish a 911 Advisory Board to assist the County Judge in furnishing advice, gathering information, and making recommendations.

Article 2. Terms

Section 1. The 911 Advisory Board shall consist of seven (7) members.

Section 2. The term for members of the 911 Advisory Board shall be three (3) years.

Section 2. The County Judge shall serve as an ex-officio member of said Board.

Article 2. <u>Appropriation:</u> It has been determined that it is in the County's best interest to permit the purchase of goods or services from General Water Conditioning.

<u>Section 1.</u> Lisa House, Justice of the Peace District #6 and owner of General Water Conditioning provides water services to Baxter County and surrounding areas.

Article 3. Effective Date: The Baxter County Quorum Court authorizes the County to transact business with the above vendor, effective immediately and in the manner prescribed by ACA § 14-14-1202.
